Respond to **4,129** requests for information, assistance, and referrals to community resources through Help Line

Welcome **41** new volunteers

Provide **124,390** meals to seniors in our Meals-on-Wheels, Senior Lunch, and Williams Center programs

Offer **15,408** hours of in-home personal care support through our Home Care program

Provide **3,177** hours of case management coordination and support through Living-at-Home

Deliver **675** shelf stable boxes of food to seniors throughout the community

Distribute nearly **4,000** masks to older adults and their families

Send **250** “smiles” to seniors, through caring notes from the community

Assist with **91** hours of virtual caregiver support

Help **68** families with activity packets, household helps, and care items at Williams Center drive-thru distributions
